



COMMEMORATING PROJECT MERCURY

Tim Gagnon, portrait and graphic artist of Titusville, FL has created this commemorative design to honor the men and women who together first put an American into space. This will be an 8" patch partially embroidered patch. The area of "space" is black twill material to make the spacecraft symbols stand out.

The design marks every manned mission in the Mercury Program. The central focus is the Mercury spacecraft in space as the Sun breaks over the Earth's horizon illustrating the dawn of a new era of exploration. The names of the Freedom 7 and Liberty Bell 7 are below the horizon illustrating that those were sub-orbital missions. Donald K. "Deke" Slayton's name is in gold signifying that while he did not fly during Mercury his contribution was essential to the success of the program.
