



CELEBRATING THE FIRST LAUNCH OF THE CONSTELLATION PROGRAM

Tim Gagnon, portrait and graphic artist of Titusville, FL announces the release of this commemorative set in his series: "Celebrating 50 Years of America in Space."

In 2004 President Bush announced that the space program would shift its focus on returning to the Moon and begin the work to travel to Mars. The Space Shuttle program would end in 2010 after completing the assembly of the International Space Station and a new vehicle would be built to accomplish the new goal. To emphasize the scope of the program it was given the name "CONSTELLATION." The first test flight is scheduled for 2009.

This set of three fully embroidered patches celebrates the first step in the new program, the launch of the Ares 1-X. The patch on the left and right are 3" x 5". The patch in the center is 4" x 4".
