

COMMEMORATING THE "MOL" PROGRAM

Tim Gagnon, portrait and graphic artist of Titusville, FL announces the release of this commemorative design the 5th in his series: "Celebrating 50 Years of America in Space."

The MOL program was an effort before the development of sophisticated satellite imagery to protect the assets of the United States against any entity that would cause us harm. Three groups of military astronauts were chosen for this program. The surnames of most of the Group 1 and Group 3 astronauts are listed in the dark blue area. The surnames of the astronauts who were transferred to NASA in 1969 and who eventually flew in space aboard the space shuttle are in the black area in the center of the patch.

This will be 6" (at the widest point) patch partially embroidered patch. Each side measures 4 inches. The dark blue area is twill material to enable the surnames to be embroidered as clearly as possible.
