The central theme of the design is the return from the Moon of the CSM "Charlie Brown" it mission almost complete. The United Kingdom is illustrated as the place on Earth the Command Module returned to (and currently is displayed). The "dot" on the letter " i " in the name "science museum" marks the location of London, England.
